Re: Delegation of authority to execute contracts on behalf of the University of Kansas

Dear Mr. Yeary:

Section II, D, 13.a.iv of the Board of Regents Policy Manual authorizes only the Chancellor and his or her designees to execute contracts on behalf of the University of Kansas. I am writing to notify you of the positions to which I have also delegated such authority to execute contracts on behalf of the University in the following three categories:

- 1) affiliation agreements within the United States;
- 2) other contracts that do not involve the expenditure of University funds; and
- 3) contracts for purchases of goods or services.

The designees include those with titles used for the same or comparable position, as may be amended by the University from time to time, and those filling these positions in "acting" or "interim" capacities.

All such contracts must still be processed and reviewed in accordance with the University's Contract Review and Signature Authority Policy.

Signature authority delegated by virtue of this letter may not be subdelegated.

AFFILIATION AGREEMENTS

Consistent with longstanding practice, as Chancellor, I will retain sole authority to sign all affiliation agreements with **foreign** universities, governments, or government agencies

The following positions are authorized to execute affiliation agreements with <u>U.S.</u> universities, agencies and entities, including University affiliated corporations:

- Chief Academic Officer, Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for Lawrence
- Chief Health Sciences Officer and Executive Vice Chancellor for KU Medical Center

Agreements for acquisition of goods or services of \$1,000,000 or more require two signatures. Such agreements shall be executed by an Executive Vice Chancellor in conjunction with the Senior Vice Chancellor of Finance/CEO.

The University of Kansas' Office of the General Counsel is designated to disseminate the above and foregoing delegation and shall provide guidance to persons designated as having authority to sign contracts on behalf of the University.
